

Alarming News

New powers are being used to clamp down on nuisance intruder alarms.

From June 2007, anyone who has an intruder alarm fitted to their property - business or residential - will be required by law to nominate a key holder and notify the City Council of their details.

This way, the council will be able to get to the root of the problem if an intruder alarm is going off and causing an inconvenience to neighbours.

Under the new laws, which have come about as part of the Clean Neighbourhoods Act 2005, the whole of Exeter will become an alarm notification area. Anyone failing to notify the Council of an existing intruder alarm can be issued with a fixed penalty notice for £75. Failure to pay the fine could result in a maximum fine, on conviction, of £1,000.
